In this Moot Court Competition, 15 teams were registered but 14 teams qualified for the competition. This edition of the competition was physically conducted at the Raffles Law School. University, Neemrana. The Moot Court Competition has been conducted under the guidance of Hon'ble (Dr.) Justice Meena V. Gomber, former Judge Court Rajasthan High Chairperson Gomber Education Foundation.





On the first day of the competition, the draw of lots and exchange of memorials took place, followed by the Inaugural Ceremony. Hon'ble (Dr.) Justice Meena V. Gomber was the Chief Guest. After the welcome address by Prof. (Dr.) Dharmender Patial. Dean Raffles Law School. Raffles University shared experience told to and the participants that mooting enables students to enhance their advocacy, legal research and writing skills. 




After the inauguration, on the 9th March, 2024 the Preliminary Rounds began and the teams participated in two intellectually demanding and grilling preliminary rounds which were adjudged by an eminent panel of academicians, judges, and practicing advocates, wherein the top eight teams qualified. On the same day, the Quarter-final rounds were organized which included the top eight teams. quarter-final rounds adjudged by a highly specialized panel of academicians, Judges and Lawyers. The top four teams that advanced to the semi-finals were TC-06 Trinity Institute of Professional Studies, Delhi, TC-07 Panjab University, Punjab, TC-08 Shastra Deemed University, Tamil Nadu, and TC-15 Noida International University, Greater Noida. These rounds were held on 10th March, 2024 adjudged by a three-judge bench each consisting of a Senior Professor, a Supreme Court Advocate-on-record and a Supreme Court Advocate.







The team TC-07 Panjab University, Punjab and TC- 15 Noida International University, Greater Noida, won the semifinal. The final round took place between these two teams on the same day. Bench o f judges for the roundcomprised of Professor (Dr.) Shailesh N. Hon'ble Registrar, Dharmashastra National Law University, Jabalpur, Dr. Suvidutt Sundaram, Advocate-on-record, Supreme Court of India and Mr. Dharamraj Ohlan, Advocate, Supreme Court of India.

TC-07 Panjab University, Punjab was adjudged as the Winner of the trophy and was awarded a cash prize of INR 20, 000. The Runners up trophy was bagged by TC-15 Noida International University, Greater Noida, with a cashprize of INR 10,000. The best speaker award with a trophy and cash prize of INR 5000 won by Ms. Tvisha Juneja from Panjab University, Punjab (TC-07).

This walk of unity has showcased that the Rafflelites have been united and promoting the liberated steps toward healthy and peaceful life. "A foot towards good life"








#### **WORKSHOP ON VIRTUAL REALITY, 4TH APRIL 2024**
