The main aim of organizing the 6th Surana & Surana and School of Law, Raffles University National Labour Law Moot Court Competition, 2023 is to establish a good overview by the students of School of Law to enhance the legal skills.

6th Surana & Surana and School of Law, Raffles University National Labour Law Moot Court Competition, 2023 was organized with our professional partner Surana & Surana International Attorneys, Chennai to fulfill this vision. The Surana and Surana International attorneys have been actively involved in keeping the mooting culture alive and they have set the bar very high.

In this Moot Court Competition, 18 were qualified teams competition. This sole edition of the competition was virtually conducted on the Cisco WebEx Platform. The Moot Court Competition has been conducted under the able guidance of our Chief Patron SOL, Hon'ble Dr. Justice Meena V. Gomber, and Mr. Preetam Surana, Advocate and Head Academic Initiatives. Surana ጲ Surana International Attorneys. The competition was supervised by the officiating Dean of the School of Law and the Faculty Coordinator of the Moot Court Committee, Ms. Amik Kaur, Mr. Anurag Sarthi, and his team. This Competition witnessed participation of 18 teams from reputed institutions across the nation. The event was spread over three days, i.e., from 03rd November November 2023.

The first day of the competition was ushered with the Inaugural Ceremony. The Competition was inaugurated by Prof. (Dr.) Paramjit S. Jaswal (Former Vice-Chancellor of RGNUL, Punjab & Currently the Vice-Chancellor of SRM University, Haryana) was the Chief Guest of the ceremony. He has made significant contributions in the fields of law that is Constitutional Administrative Law, Human Rights, and Environmental Law, his Book on "Environmental Law" second edition (2003) has been cited thrice by the Supreme Court of India in the landmark judgment reported as In Re: Noise pollution (V) (2005) 5 SCC 733. By Hon'ble Justice R.C. Lahoti, the Chief Justice of India.

After the welcome address by Dr. Ausaf Ahmad Malik, Officiating Dean SOL, Raffles University, the Hon'ble Justice Meena V. Gomber shared her views and experiences of being part of the legal regime. She encouraged and motivated all the students to build upon their skills and thrive in their desired fields. It was then proceeded by the Chief Guest Prof. (Dr.) Paramjit S. Jaswal addressed the gathering by congratulating the teachers and students of the School of Law for organizing competition that attracted participants from all over the country. He said that the simple fact of participating such activities is more important than winning losing. While a healthy sense of competition does indeed motivate law students improve their skills, in the long run, they must remember that there are shades of grey when they eventually take up legal practice. The inaugural session was concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Anurag Sarthi Assistant Professor SOL, Raffles University.









After the inauguration, the Preliminary Rounds began and the teams participated in two intellectually demanding and grilling preliminary rounds which were adjudged by an eminent panel of academicians, judges, and practicing advocates. The Preliminary Rounds were followed by the Quarter-final rounds which included the top eight teams. The quarter-final rounds were adjudged by a highly specialized panel of academicians, Judges, and Lawyers. The top four teams that advanced to the semifinals were, Tamil Nadu National Law University (LL-1), School of Law, Christ (Deemed To Be University) (LL-2), Symbiosis Law School, Noida (LL-11), School of Legal Studies, CUSAT (LL-12). These rounds were adjudged by two-judge benches each consisting of a senior professor, and a Judge.

On 04th November 2023 Semi-final was held. The team Tamil Nadu National Law University (LL-1) and School of Law, Christ (Deemed To Be University) (LL-2) won the semi-final. The final round took place between these two teams on November 5th, 2023. The Bench of judges for the final comprised of Hon'ble Justice Rekha Sharma, Former Judge, Delhi High Court, Prof (Dr.) Anurag Deep, Professor, Indian Law Institute, Mr. Sunil Mathews, Senior Advocate, Dr. Abdul Qadir Pasha, Labour Enforcement Officer (Central) And Mr. Hari Narayana, Senior Partner, United Maritime Law Chambers.



Tamil Nadu National Law University (LL-1) was adjudged as the Winner of the trophy and was awarded a cash prize of INR 21, 000. The Runners up trophy was bagged by School of Law, Christ (Deemed To Be University) (LL02), with a cash prize of INR 11,000. Tamil Nadu National Law University (LL-1) was awarded Best Memorial with a cash prize of INR 5100. The Best Student Advocate award with a cash prize of INR 5100 was won by Ishita Mishra from Symbiosis Law School Pune (LL-18)

In the Valedictory Session, the Hon'ble judges for the final round, our Chief Guest Justice Rekha Mishra, Guest of Honor Hon'ble Dr. Justice Meena V. Gomber addressed the students with their monumental knowledge and experiences, which proved to be a great takeaway for all the attendees. 














PRABANDHOTSAV 2.0

AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION DAY 3rd December, 2023







13th January, 2024


