The School of law, Raffles University, Neemrana has always envisioned serving society through reforms in legal services by way of preparing professionally competent lawyers. The 7th Edition of C.L. Agrawal Memorial National Moot Court Competition, 2023 was organised in association with Rajasthan Education Trust in continuance to fulfil this vision.

In this Moot Court Competition, 18 teams were registered but 13 teams qualified for the competition. This sole edition of the competition was physically conducted at the School of Law, Raffles University, Neemrana. The Moot Court Competition has been conducted under the able guidance of Hon'ble Dr. Justice Meena V. Gomber, former Judge Rajasthan High Court & Chairperson Gomber Education Foundation and Mr. Justice V.S Dave former judge Rajasthan High Court.






LOHRI FESTIVAL (13th JANUARY 2023)








NUKKAD NATAK (12th MARCH 2023)

INDUSTRIAL VISIT (DURING THE SESSION)


