Raffles University situated in NCR at Neemrana, on Delhi- Jaipur National Highway No. 48, is just 90 Kms away from Delhi International Airport and is also connected by a six lane express way and by railway line at Rewari Junction. The distance from Jaipur is 140 Kms. The state of the art infrastructure with all modern facilities, built on a sprawling 50 Acres of land, is set in an unpolluted serene environment in the lap of Aravali hills. 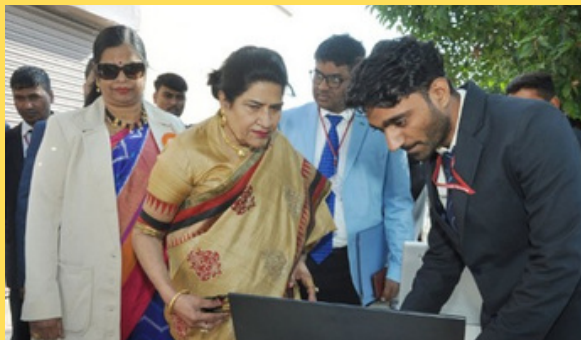

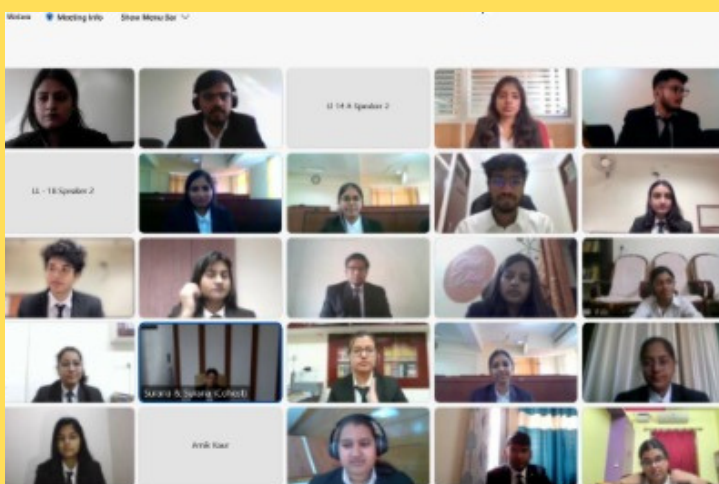

**HUMAN RIGHTS DAY (10 DECEMBER 2022)**

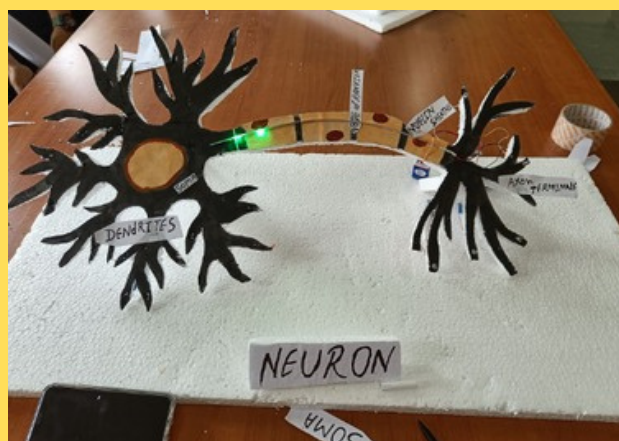

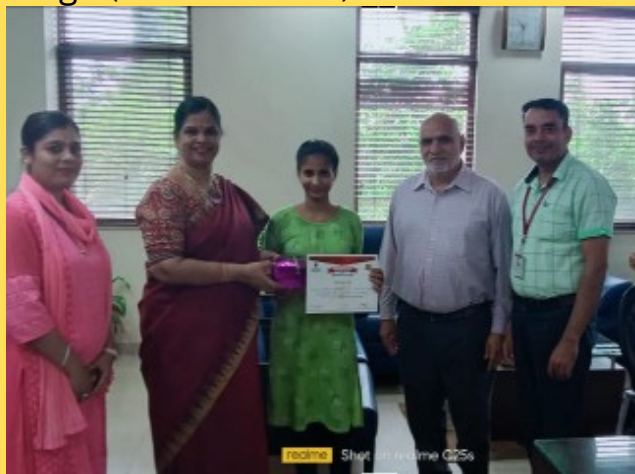
Extension Lecture During Session

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

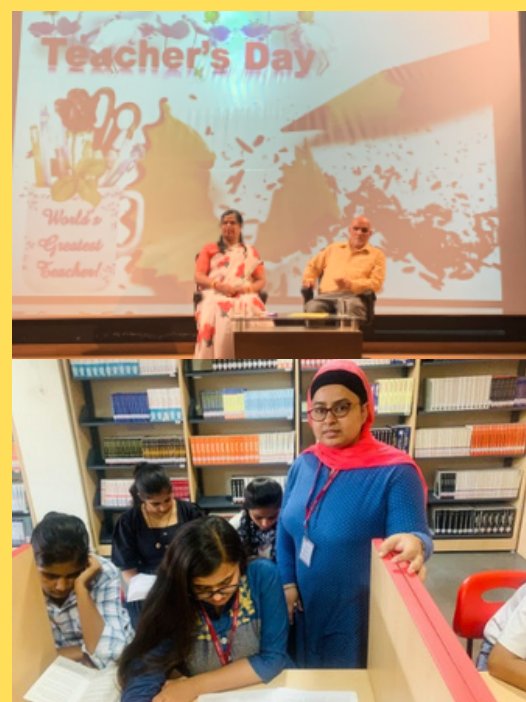
